

Shipyard Safety Instruction Course for Workers (General Trade) (SSIC GT)

Course Overview

The Workplace Safety and Health (Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing) Regulations 2008 Reg. 6 (2) stipulates that "It shall be the duty of every person not to carry out any work deemed hazardous in a shipyard or on board a ship in a harbor unless he has undergone a safety and health training course approved by the commissioner for Workplace Safety and Health".

Who Should Attend the Course?

The SSIC is a mandatory WSH training course for all workers working in the shipbuilding and ship repairing industry. Shippard workers are required to go through the SSIC before they start work at the shippard.

Assessment: Written Test (MCQ)/Theory

Attendance: 100 % (Required)

Passing Mark: 60% for each assessment mode

Certification: Upon successful completion of the course a safety pass endorsed by
